Key APEC Targets for 2015 and Beyond

- (i) Bogor goal of achieving Free and open Trade and Investment by 2010 for developed members and by 2020 for developing members of APEC (1994)
- (ii) 10% improvement in supply chain performance by 2015 in terms of time, cost and uncertainty (of APEC supply chain framework) using 2009 as a base (2009)
- (iii) Aspirational goal of a 25% improvement on 'Ease of Doing business' by 2015, taking 2009 as a base in five priority areas: Starting a business, getting credit, trading across borders, enforcing contracts and dealing in permits
- (iv) Reduction of tariffs on APEC List of Environmental Goods to 5% or less by the end of 2015
- (v) 1 Million intra APEC University students by 2020 (2013)
- (vi) Reduction of aggregate energy intensity by 45% by 2035 using 2005 as a base year (2012)
- (vii) Achieving universal broad band access in APEC region by 2015
- (viii) Achieving convergence on regulatory approval procedures for medical products by 2020
- (ix) Aspirational goal of increasing forest cover in the region by at least 20 million hectares of all types of forests by 2020
- (x) Conserve at least 10% of coastal and marine areas, including through effectively managed marine protected areas (MPAs) and other area-based conservation measures, by 2020
- (xi) Aspirational goal of doubling the share of renewables in the APEC energy mix, including in power generation, from 2010 levels by 2030
